



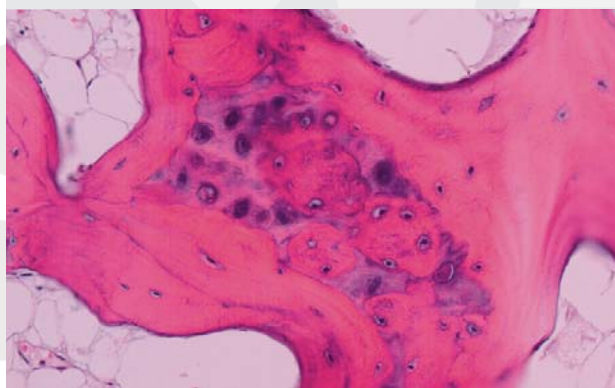

- *Robert Schenk Prize for Basic Research on Bone*
- *Robert Schenk Prize for Applied & Clinical Research*

Both awards are endowed with prize money of CHF 15'000 and are presented annually in honor of Prof. Robert Schenk.

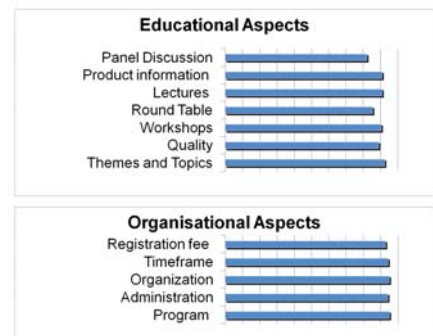

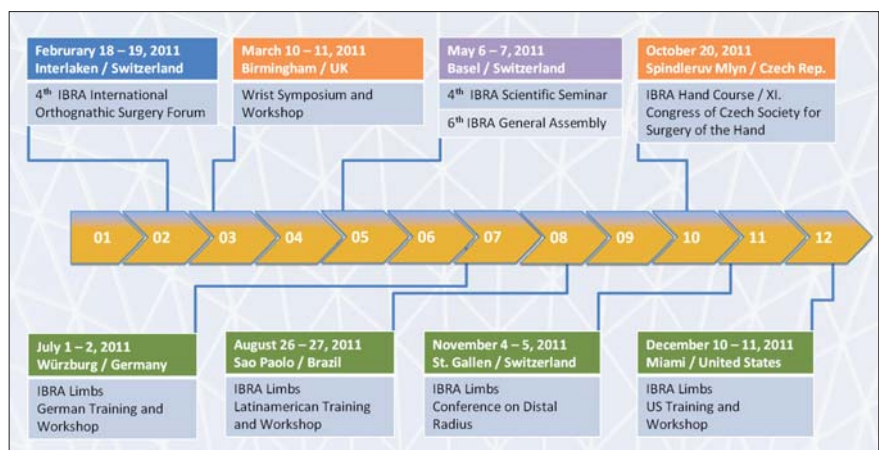

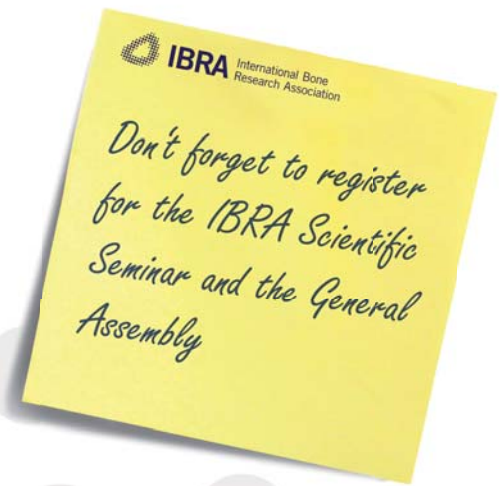
